Other costs to be considered on either program;

T.P.S. offers a one month complementary membership with the Australian Skydiving Association as part of your Stage 1 Weekend course. On its expiry you are required to renew you're A.S.A. membership at their prescribed fees for one years membership (01.02.of the year to 31.1 of the following year) @ \$120.00 or \$11.00 per month pro rata to 31.01 of the following year.

T.P.S. supplies all first jumpers with a temporary log book that is sufficient for two jumps. It is legally required to log all skydives and therefore a permanent logbook would need to be purchased after your second jump. Cost \$25.00 (Inc Free on 7 day course)

T.P.S. waivers the standard Drop Zone Fee over the weekend first jump course. After the initial course and your first jump, a \$10.00 per day D.Z. fee applies to all jumpers. This fee is a facility use fee and it helps to keep jump prices down. (D.Z. fee inc free for 7 day course, fee applies after initial 7 days).

While you are a student jumper all equipment is supplied by T.P.S. it is however recommended that you purchase your own goggles as soon as possible. Standard cost \$25.00

When using T.P.S. equipment a \$70.00 holding deposit is required to safe guard equipment. These monies are fully refundable upon the return of the equipment.

Currency is your ticket to safety. Skydivers are expected to jump once every four weeks to remain current and safe in the sport. **Retraining fees apply if you do not jump at regular intervals.** If applicable, a review jump may be required if you allow yourself to become uncurrent in the sport. The fee for this jump is at the standard rate and is in addition to retraining fees. You will be advised during your first jump course all safety requirements.

Services The Parachute School offers FREE of charge.

T.P.S. teaches packing at NO charge. (You must know how to pack to apply for you're A. Licence)

T.P.S. has A.S.A. Operational Regulations for your use to study for you're A. Licence exam.

T.P.S. Chief Instructor offers help and advice when purchasing your own equipment.

(You will need a Rig comprising of a main parachute, a reserve parachute, a container and AAD, Goggles, Helmet, Altimeter and a jump suit.)

To apply for you're A. Licence you need to,

- Complete the minimum required jumps, as per the training program.
- Pack a minimum of 20 parachutes under supervision and complete a packing exam
- Sit and pass an A. licence exam based on the Operational Regulations.

With the Chief Instructors approval you can then apply to A.S.A. for an A. licence the cost for this licence is \$90.00.

T.P.S. will assist and guide you in your skydiving venture. It is our policy to produce safe and competent skydivers for the future. Many Instructors and Australian Champion competitors started skydiving with The Parachute School.

T.P.S. offers a very friendly and inviting atmosphere where all staff and jumpers from the commencement of your first jump course will welcome you.

T.P.S. looks forward to helping you become a skydiver; we hope this information pack provides you with an honest and informative idea about the costs involved with skydiving so you can make a decision based on your budget. The great news is once you have you're A. licence and your own equipment, a jump from height (10,000 to 14,000 ft) is \$40.00 or less per jump.
